A huge "THANK YOU" goes out to all of our "YES" voters! We are happy to announce our Levy passed by an astounding 70.5%! (20,532) yes votes compared to 29.95 percent (8,780) no votes. The Pierce County Auditor's Office certified these election results 2-24-10. The levy will provide \$42 million in 2011, \$44.5 million in 2012, \$47 million in 2013, and \$49.5 million in 2014.

Way to go Puyallup voters!

- \*Teachers and support staff
- \*Programs for students with special needs
- \*School safety and security
- \*Smaller class sizes
